

- UNIFORM RESOURCE LOCATOR The address used for locating a document on the Web (URL). (24)
- WEB PAGE A document which can display text, graphics, audio, video and other elements through a web browser. (8)
- HTML TAG Special codes which describe or define content in a Web document. (8)
- DOMAIN NAME SYSTEM Internet service that translates domain names into IP addresses. (18)
- 12. HTML A language which means that special codes are used to define elements. (4)
- WORLD WIDE WEB A worldwide network of computers that communicate through http. (14)
- 16. HTML ELEMENT The opening and closing tags including the text in between. (12)
- CSS PROPERTY The style attribute you want to change. (12)
- WEB SERVER A computer that runs special software to serve up Web content by responding to requests. (10)
- ABSOLUTE LINK A link that specifies a complete path to a file, including the protocol, server, directory, filename. (13)
- OPEN STANDARD A standard that is publicly available and has various rights to use associated with it, and may also have various properties of how it was designed. (13)
- 24. INTERNET PROTOCOL A numeric string that identifies a device on a network. (IP) (17)
- 25. WEB ACCESSIBILITY INITIATIVE A program for developing strategies, guidelines, and resources to help make the Web accessible to people with disabilities (WAI). (28)

- WORLD WIDE WEB CONSORTIUM An international community that develops open standards for the Web (W3C). (25)
- 3. HYPERTEXT TRANSPORT PROTOCOL The underlying protocol for how content is communicated on the Web (HTTP). (28)
- HTML ATTRIBUTE Provide HTML attributes with additional meaning and context. (14)
- CASCADING STYLE SHEET A language for defining how to display HTML elements. (21)
- 7. HEXADECIMAL COLOR CODES Color values written with the # sign followed by six digits using The numbers 0 to 9 and A to F to represent the amount of red, green and blue. (23)

- 8. CSS SELECTOR The HTML element that you want to style. (12)
- RELATIVE LINK A link that specifies the name of the file to be linked to as it relates to the current document. (13)
- CSS DECLARATION The style property and value. (15)
- WEB BROWSER Special software that displays the page by reading the instructions in the web document. (11)
- NESTING Putting an object inside another object; such as an HTML tag inside another HTML tag. (7)
- RGB COLOR CODES Color values using the combination of red, green, and blue values ranging from 0 to 255. (15)
- CSS VALUE The attribute you want applied to the property. (9)
- 22. WEBSITE A collection of related webpages with a starting point or home page (7)
